

Coaching – KCIC Off Ice Harness Conditions of Use

Prior to using the motorized off-ice harness/spinner (harness) at KCIC for skater training, I acknowledge and agree to the following:

Coaching Eligibility to Use Harness

- I am a USFS compliant coach
- I am a current coaching member in good standing of either Silver Blades Figure Skating Club of Greater Kansas City (Silver Blades FSC) or Kansas City Figure Skating Club (KCFSC)
- I am eligible to coach on JoCo Club Ice sessions at Kansas City Ice Center (guest coaches are not eligible)
- I have attended a training session held by an approved Silver Blades FSC coach and have been granted permission to use the harness for training sessions (Current approved coaches: Wendy David, Sharon Brilliantine, Jan Sullivan, Lisa Jordan)

Harness Usage and Availability

- Harness usage is taken at the coach's and skater's own risk. Silver Blades FSC and KCIC are not liable for any injuries sustained during training sessions on the harness
- I will only use the harness during times designated on the Sign-Up Genius
- I will sign up for training sessions on the Sign-Up Genius in advance
- I acknowledge that I must sign up for training session times and not my skater(s)
- I will not change any settings on the harness other than speed up/down

Harness Care and Maintenance

- I am responsible for monitoring and maintaining all harness equipment during my scheduled training session(s)
- I will put all harness related equipment (equipment) away in the designated secure location if I am the last one using it (equipment includes, but is not limited to: motorized spinner, belt, remote(s), rope)
- The harness cannot be left out between sessions throughout the day (must be put away after morning session and brought back out in the afternoon)
- I am responsible for and will pay for any lost, stolen or damaged items if I fail to appropriately handle and store the harness and its related equipment
- Will report potential damages or issues immediately to KCIC rink management and the Silver Blades FSC
- I will immediately notify rink management and other coaches of potential safety issues or concerns so that training can be postponed until issues are investigated and resolved

Skater Eligibility to Use Harness

I acknowledge and agree that I will follow the below guidelines for placing a skater on the harness:

- Skater is a member in good standing of Silver Blades FSC or KCFSC or is an associate member of one of these clubs

- Skater or parent/guardian (if under 18 years of age) has reviewed, agreed to, and signed the “Skater Terms of Use and Release of Liability” form
- I will ensure the skater uses the equipment appropriately and responsibly
- I am responsible for damages caused by my skater(s) while using the harness
- Skater is working on at least an Axel jump
- Skater must be supervised at all times during the training session and cannot use the harness without an approved coach as defined above

If I do not follow the guidelines established above, my approval for using the harness will be revoked indefinitely and can only be reinstated with approval from the Silver Blades FSC Board of Directors. I will also pay for any damages or replacement items caused by my non-compliance with the above.
